

## Be A Sheepdog Sleuth Help Us Find "Elliot"

Elliot is a 29 month old male OES Service Dog. He went missing almost a year ago. His people have advertised and checked the usual places, to no avail. Elliot was most likely abducted. His owner says he was in the backyard one moment - and then gone. Searchers found dog footprints and human footprints in the wooded area behind the house. Neighbors had seen campfires in the woods and there might have been drug activity in the area. Although Elliot is very friendly, he would not have left his home voluntarily.



Elliot's home is in Seabeck - on the Olympic Peninsula. We're hoping that after this long, he has been adopted and is safe in a good home. His people are still trying to find him. Elliot could be anywhere by now - so even if you don't live in NW Washington, please watch for him.

Because he might be in long or short coat, here are his actual coat markings: He has a white muzzle and forehead, both ears are gray (the right ear has a strip of white towards the front, the left ear has a small spot of white about the same height as his eye). His eyes are brown. His front left leg is white on the top and gray on the bottom until just above the ankle. His back legs are gray until just above the ankles. His tail is about 3" long and when he runs, his tail sticks up like a little flag. Elliot is 27" at the shoulder and weighed about 80 pounds when abducted. Elliot has scarring from a hernia repair when he was a pup and he has a Home Again microchip.

We all notice when someone is walking a sheepdog. Please take the time to come up and visit with anyone with a sheepdog. Tell them about the OES clubs - see if you can get their name, number, or location. If Elliot was sold for drug money, his new owners won't know that he has a loving home and family waiting for him.

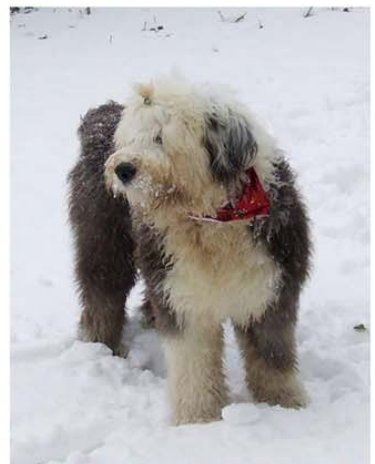


The next time you visit your veterinarian, grooming facility, training class, or see other people walking their OES - please tell them about Elliot.
